Parent Code of Conduct:

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in the Town of Farmville Youth Football/Cheerleading Program by following this Parent Code of Conduct: I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all participants, coaches, and officials. I will do my best to make this program fun for my child. I will keep winning in perspective. A child usually forgets the outcome of the game; it is the adults who tend to stress the win/loss record. I will ask my child to treat other participants, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect regardless of race, age, gender, creed, or ability. I will treat officials and coaches with respect. They are there to provide my child with a safe and healthy learning environment. Officials and coaches deserve the same type of environment as the parents and spectators. I will strive to be a good role model for my child and the other children in the program. This is necessary for my child to know the game plan and be prepared by the coaches to participate in the upcoming games.
