Camper Code of Conduct

To maintain a safe, fun, and productive camp environment, we require parents and campers to read and understand the importance of abiding by the following code of conduct:

- All participants should treat all others and themselves with respect. Aggressive, abusive, and vulgar language and behavior toward others (fighting, threats, insults, cursing, discrimination) are not permitted. Participants should also respect the privacy of others.
- Possession of weapons, knives, and other items that can be used illegally are not permitted at Recreation Programs.
- Possession, distribution, or use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, and unauthorized prescription drugs is not permitted at any Recreation Program.
- Participants should respect the property of others and be responsible. Deliberate destruction or removal of items is not permitted. Financial responsibility for any damage caused by deliberate destruction will be assumed by the participant and/or parents/quardians.
- Participants are expected to dress appropriately based on the guidelines/expectations of the Recreation program.
- Animals and pets are not allowed at Recreation programs unless needed to accommodate a disability or part of the recreation program through prior authorization.





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Town of Farmville Summer Day Camp Disciplinary Policy

Summer camp is meant to be a fun, educational, and recreational activity, and participants must behave appropriately during the summer day camp. <u>Unacceptable behavior during the Parks and Recreation Program (defined by the program outlines and the Code of Conduct) will result in consequences for the participant. In all <u>actions, all parents/guardians (or participants if an adult) will be notified of the behavior and potential</u> <u>disciplinary action.</u> If disciplinary action becomes necessary for the participant, the steps will be followed as outlined below:</u>

- 1. The camper will receive a verbal warning and an explanation as to why the behavior is inappropriate (whenever possible, this will be done in a secluded setting, away from other campers).
- 2. Exclusion from participating in an activity if the behavior is preventing other participants from taking part in the activity.
- 3. Early release from program/event without refund.
- 4. Restitution or repayment of damages.
- 5. Releasing participants to appropriate law enforcement agencies and/or proper authorities.
- 6. The Summer Camp Staff of the Farmville Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to prohibit any participant from summer camps following the first incident in cases of seriously inappropriate behavior.

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Farmville Parks and Recreation Day Camp Rules & Policies

- 1. Participants must follow the Farmville Parks and Recreation Department's Camper Code of Conduct.

 All participants must sign these policies before the start of camp.
- 2. All campers must have a completed registration form and medical information form on file by the stated deadline. No camper will be allowed to start participating in the camp until all fees and all forms are completed by the arranged deadline.
- 3. Activities will follow the Challenge by Choice principle. This means that the group will offer support and encouragement but will not push someone into activity through peer pressure. We want to encourage everyone to participate, however, if the participant does not want to take part in the planned activity (e.g., swimming, climbing tower, etc.), the participant may take part in an alternative activity led by Parks and Recreation staff.
- 4. **Medication**: Farmville Parks and Recreation Department staff is not permitted to accept or dispense medication of any kind (except in the event of an emergency) unless a dispense medication form has been filled out by a parent or guardian. It will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to administer medication to the child.
- 5. **Lunch:** If a camper chooses not to eat the lunch that is provided, please send a nonperishable lunch with a drink to camp every day. Mark the lunch box/bag with the child's name. Camp counselors will need to inspect the lunch when it is brought in.
- 6. **Water:** The weather during camp is usually very hot. Drinking fountains are available, but we suggest you send extra bottles of water to camp with your child labeled clearly with the child's name.
- 7. **Swimming:** During the Summer Camp Program, campers will be allowed to swim in different swimming areas. Proper swim attire is required, and it is suggested that it be provided every day. Please, no leotards, shorts with zippers belt loops, etc. Label swim bags and towels clearly with the child's name. We recommend you send sunscreen daily and instruct your child on how to apply sunscreen before attending camp. Each camper will be required to take a swim test before water-related activities. If your child <u>CANNOT</u> swim or has <u>any</u> difficulty swimming at all, please send him/her with a life jacket or floaties to camp every day.
- 8. Programs are limited to registered participants only; visitors or guests will not be permitted.
- 9. Drop Off/Pick Up:
 - Pick-up and drop-off location is at the Firemen's Sports Arena (1328 Zion Hill Rd. Farmville, VA 23901)
 - Parents should be punctual in dropping off and picking up campers. All campers must be signed in before entering camp and signed out before leaving.
 - The camp day begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m.
 - Staff supervision begins at **7:30 a.m.** and ends at **5:30 p.m.** Campers are not allowed to be dropped off any earlier than 7:30 a.m. and/or picked up any later than 5:30 p.m.
 - Please notify the Parks and Recreation Department if your child will be dropped off later or picked up earlier than the designated times.
 - Participants must be picked up on time from camp; if not picked up by 5:30 p.m., participants will be taken to the Police Department.
