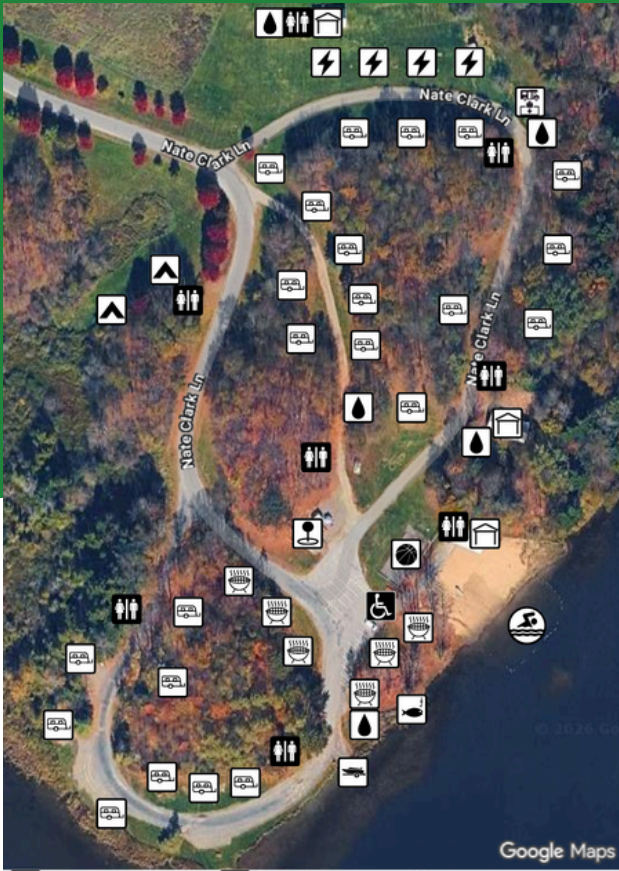

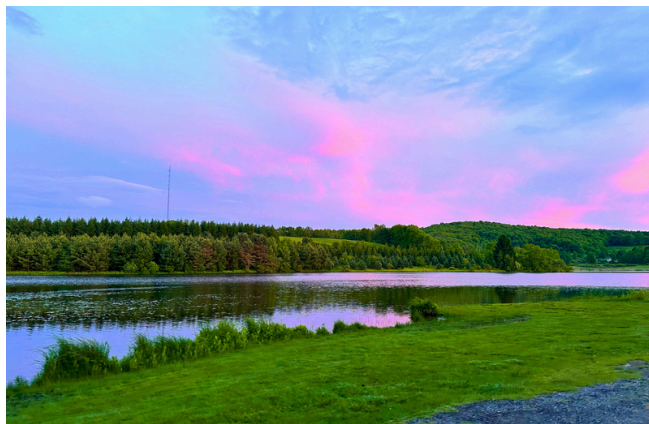

# **CAMPGROUND**

---

Camp sites and Pavilion use is by reservation only. Reservations may be up to two weeks long. No season rental option. Check in starts at 1pm. Check out by 11am.

Camping rental includes one complimentary septage dump per reservation at the time of check out. Additional septage disposal available for a \$35 fee each and must be scheduled through the office.

## **2024 Fee Schedule:**

Primitive Site (per night) -----> \$25

Utility Site (per night) -----> \$40

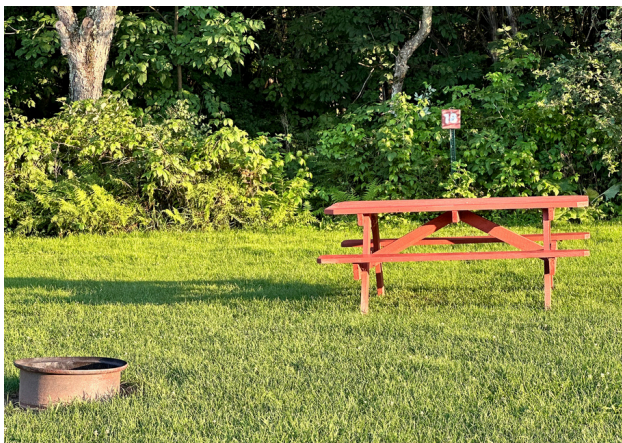
Pavilion (per 2 hour block) -----> \$32

## **Refund Schedule:**

Up to 7 days prior to rental --> no refund

8-13 days prior to rental ---> 50% refund

14+ days prior to rental -----> full refund



# **ACTIVITIES**

## **Public Beach & Playground**

---

The beach is open to the public for swimming and sunbathing, with playground equipment including swings. Swimming only permitted while Beach Attendant is on duty, and all kids under 16 must be supervised by an adult. No dogs, alcohol, smoking, or vaping allowed on the beach or in the Sandpiper Pavilion. Also available is a basketball court, must bring your own ball.

The Sandpiper Pavilion is available for use to all patrons using the beach. There are two handicap accessible bathrooms in the pavilion, as well as two changing rooms and several picnic tables.

## **Fishing & Boating**

---

The boat launch is available for boating and licensed fishing. Boaters must have flotation devices. No gas motors allowed.

## **Hiking & Picnicing**

---

The hiking trail around Millbrook is approximately 1.6 miles long, and circles the reservoir. Picnic tables with grills at the front of the park are available without reservations.



# **DOC MEYERS RECREATION PARK**

---

Millbrook Reservoir is a municipal park operated by the Town of New Berlin and opened in 1996. The recreation area was dedicated to Merritt “Doc” Meyers, in honor of his donation of the property for use as a park. The park offers camping, swimming, fishing, non-motorized boating, picnicking, and a 1.6 mile walking trail.
