Dear Community Member:

Since 1976, Family of New Paltz has been helping community members with “any problem under the sun”. The agency was founded on three core principles: treat everyone with respect, don’t tell people what to do, and don’t burden people with our judgement about what they’ve done. We offer support around key issues such as housing, food insecurity, clothing/basic necessities, employment, domestic violence, and emergency financial needs to name just a few.

Here are some of our accomplishments from 2025:

- **7,565** individuals and families received support through crisis intervention, emergency services, food, clothing, case management, and community resources.
- **54** individuals and families received intensive case management services to help stabilize overwhelming life situations and disabilities.
- **164** individuals impacted by substance abuse/addiction received support through referrals, advocacy, counseling, self-help groups, and rehabilitation services.
- **121** individuals addressed mental health challenges, trauma, and abuse through counseling and mental health referrals.
- **560** individuals and families stabilized their finances and housing through access to benefits and public assistance programs.
- **497** individuals and families secured or maintained permanent housing with advocacy and housing support services.
- **477** individuals increased self-sufficiency through job readiness, vocational skill development, and employment assistance.
- **4,205** individuals received food assistance through the pantry, while expanded community collaborations supported an additional 4,477 individuals.
- **37** survivors of domestic violence and perpetrators sought support, referrals, and legal service connections
