- <u>Softball</u>
 - o <u>Schedule:</u>
 - Weeknight practices are set by the coach's preferences. Games range from 6pm start time to 7:30pm start time on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. Wednesdays will be a last resort.
 - o <u>Equipment:</u>
 - The Recreation Department will provide Jersey, socks, hat, belt.
 - Parents are expected to provide pants, helmets, face masks, bats, gloves, and cleats.
 - A helmet with face mask is required for all age groups.
 - An infield face mask is highly recommended.
 - Pitcher face mask is required.
 - Bat size varies amongst players. While the bat is set next to the player's side, the end knob should reach the wrist and should have no difficulty swinging.
 - Approved bats must have USSSA or USA stamps.
 - Gloves also vary amongst players.
 - Only 13U+ players are allowed to have metal cleats.
