Monroe County Recreation Department All-Star Rules, Policies, & Format

- 1. The Head Coach for the All-Star team will be the Coach that wins the end of season tournament for that league/age division. If there are two All-star teams in an age group, the second team coach will be the regular season champion. If the same team wins both, the coach of the second team will be the tournament runner up.
- 2. In the case where we are required to have multiple teams, the 1st place coach will be considered Team 1, 2nd place Team 2, and so on. Team 1 will select their team first. Players will play for the coach/team for which they are selected. The only exception is if the parent was a certified coach for one of the other teams and wishes to continue coaching with that head coach.
- Each regular season Head Coach will be asked to provide Allstar nominations from their team. This list should be players that have excelled this season and deserve the chance to represent Monroe County.
- 4. Coaches will have a deadline to get their All-Star Nominations back to the Sports Coordinators. The nominations should remain confidential from parents and players.
- 5. Coaches will have the option of running a try out or simply selecting their team from the list of nominations.

- 6. Once team is selected, it will be the Allstar coaches responsibility to work with the Rec Dept. to secure any necessary documents.
- 7. As a staff we would like to see a player represented from each team in the league, but we do not force this. We want to send our best players and best team possible to represent MCRD.
